Advance in the automotive industry when you learn the advantages and limitations of alternative fuel vehicles. The Evergreen Valley College Automotive program offers 33 courses including Introduction to Alternative Vehicles and an advanced Hybrid Maintenance and Repair course.

Evergreen Valley College is a Honda Factory Certified Training Center and one of a few community colleges that give students access to specialized tools used to test and repair electric hybrid vehicles. Students can qualify for Honda Professional Automotive Career Training certification with additional coursework as well as certify through the National Institute for Automotive Service Excellence.

Find Your Opportunity

Alternative fuel vehicle courses at Evergreen Valley College can enrich your skills as an automotive service technician, provide unique safety skills for emergency response personnel and supply the background to work for hybrid and alternative fuel car manufacturers.

Entry level automotive service technicians start at \$14 to \$18 per hour and can advance to \$35 per hour. Gaining alternative fuel vehicle maintenance skills can increase opportunities for promotion. Graduates work for Honda, General Motors, Ford and Tesla Motors.
